Higher Hurdsfield Parish Council response to the proposed boundary change from Bollington ward to Hurdsfield ward.

Having discussed the subject at length, Higher Hurdsfield Parish Council are of the opinion that we should stay in the Bollington ward. The reasoning behind this decision is as follows.

Higher Hurdsfield village is essentially a strip village of residential properties following Rainow Road from the canal bridge almost to the junction at Kerridge End. During the 1960s and then later in the 1980s the Roewood Lane estate was constructed just inside the village on the eastern side of the canal. The rest of the village is predominantly agricultural land with farms and the 19th century Swanscoe Hall.

Therefore, we feel that we are more aligned to the rural community of the Bollington ward than the urban community of the Hurdsfield ward.
