It is critical that Huish Champflower continues the close ties with the other parishes in the existing Dulverton & Exmoor district. As a rural, sparsely populated parish, with a largely land-based economy, we have much in common with our neighbouring Brendon Hills and Exmoor parishes. The Exmoor LCN is a great help to us, as is the superb support we receive from our County Councillors. We are part of a very effective community of common interest and it would be criminal if this were to be changed and the benefits removed from our residents. However the reorganisation proceeds - and I sincerely hope that common-sense prevails - our ties, links and liaisons with our neighbouring Brendon Hills & Exmoor parishes must be preserved. Splitting the existing district South to North along the River Exe, and up through the River Quarme, and then the River Avill forms the basis for two districts which can still meet collectively as the Exmoor LCN and continue our community of common interest.
