Dear LGBCE,

North Curry Parish Council wishes to express its desire for North Curry to remain with Stoke St Gregory in revised boundary groupings. Some other groupings have been suggested which instead group North Curry with Ruishton and Creech St Michael, which the Parish Council feels is inappropriate as North Curry has much less in common with these parishes in comparison to Stoke St Gregory.

North Curry and Stoke St Gregory share many services, facilities, and farming communities; specifically, the two parishes share a bus service, road infrastructure, flooding and traffic issues, and joint church benefice (the Athelney Benefice consisting of North Curry, Stoke St Gregory, Burrowbridge, and East Lyng churches), as well as many others. For these reasons, the Parish Council strongly believes that North Curry should remain grouped with Stoke St Gregory.
