I live in Cradley Heath near the border with Dudley Council. Whilst these boundary changes cannot fix the arbitrary division in my local area between Dudley and Sandwell, they can at least ensure that two towns are united in their own wards as opposite to the current situation. Those are Cradley Heath and Old Hill.

I support the submission of Halesowen Conservative Association that resolves this problem and puts all of Cradley Heath in its own ward, whilst it unites Old Hill that is currently split between Cradley Heath & Old Hill and Rowley, and if you include Powke Lane as part of Old Hill, then you could say that it is actually split across three wards.

The solution where Blackheath & Old Hill become one joined ward, including all parts of both towns, whilst Cradley Heath would become its own ward and the remaining parts of Rowley Regis form a Rowley ward would be far better than the current situation where local ties are not fully respected and neighbouring properties are split apart from one another.
