Hi,

My comments about the Wirral boundary review are:

1. The suggested name changes - Upton will become Upton and Woodchurch, Liscard will become Liscard and Egremont, Claughton changes to Claughton and Noctorum..I confirm that I support these changes. These names are more reflective of the ward areas that they represent.
2. Support the moving of the boundary between Bromborough and Clatterbridge wards from the railway line to Bromborough Road and the Dibbinsdale Brook (paragraph 58) as this unites the currently split Spital community. Spital station is a local focal point and is used by the local residents. They identify with living in Spital and currently feel that the community is split. This is not reflective of the local area, as they use Spital train station stop rather than Bromborough. The three stags pub is also a local focal point and residents from Spital use this rather than Bromborough pubs. Additionally, the local shops are at Lancelyn precinct and are used by locals, rather than Bromborough shops. There are therefore key focal points in this community that draw it together.

I therefore suggest that the Commission accepts these proposals as they fit well with local communities.
