I would like to take the opportunity to thank the Local Government Boundary Commission for England (LGBCE) for their report containing well thought out and logical proposals.

The Conservative Group supports the proposals set out in the report, and while there are minor elements we differ on with the Commission, we understand the decisions the Commission have come to when considering the report in its totality, in order to maintain electoral equality across the whole Borough.

The Conservative Group supports the LGBCE's view that Wirral's residents are effectively represented by 66 councillors across 22 wards.

We welcome the LGBCE's proposed name changes for three wards: Upton becoming Upton and Woodchurch, Liscard becoming Liscard and Egremont, Claughton becoming Claughton and Noctorum as they better reflect the communities that make up those wards.

We also support the recommendation to reunite the Spital community by moving the boundary between Clatterbridge and Bromborough wards to follow the natural line of the Dibbinsdale Brook (rather than the railway line).
