Related subject: Proposed Boroughbridge Division

The proposed Boroughbridge Division boundary makes no sense at all. It is bisected by the River Ure - the 1,200 year old boundary between the West and North Ridings of Yorkshire. North of the River, the area covered by the rural Kirby Hill & District Parish Council spans THREE separate Divisions in the new proposals, meaning that three County Councillors will need to attend the PC meetings. It would be far better to respect the existing boundaries and include the rural hinterland north of Boroughbridge in a single division whose boundaries align with the rural parish boundaries.
