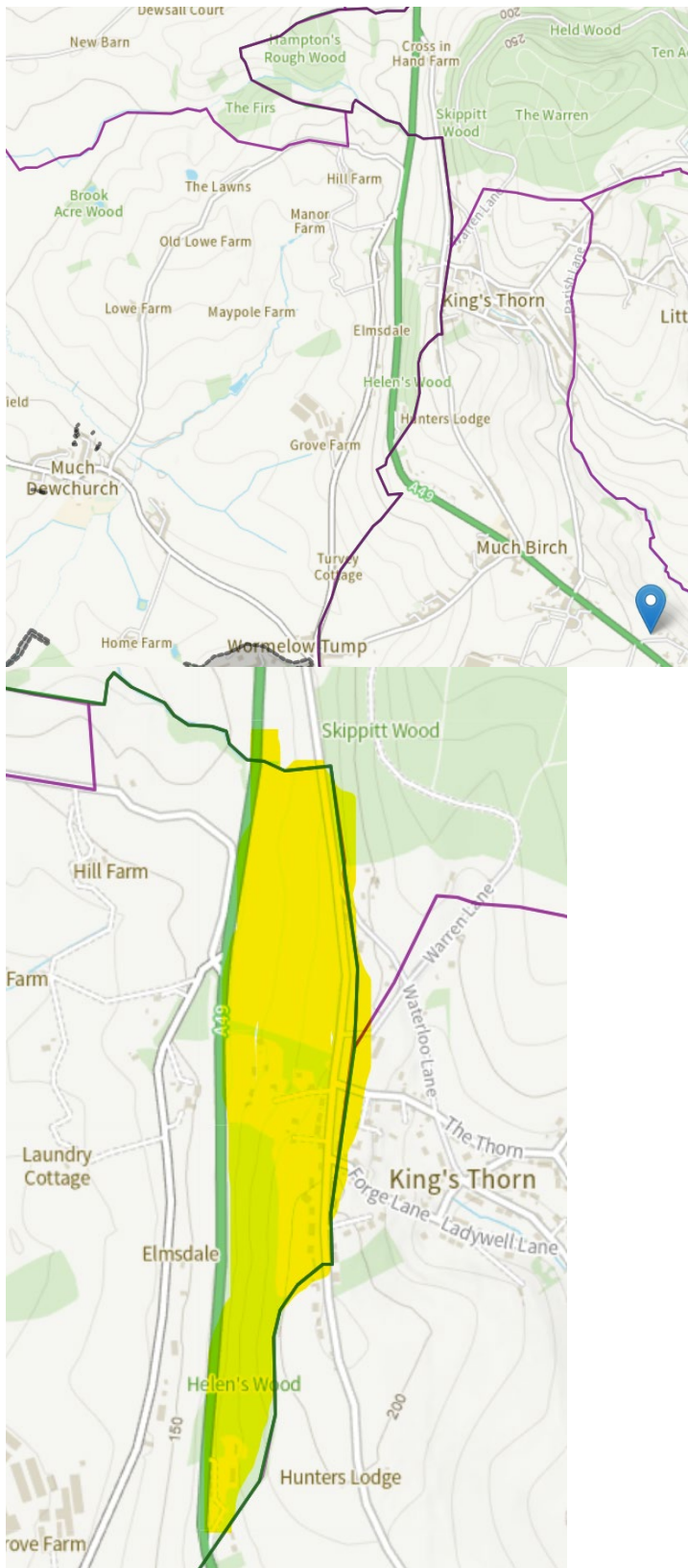

**Related subject:** Birch Ward and Wormside Ward at Kingsthorpe, Much Birch and Orcop.

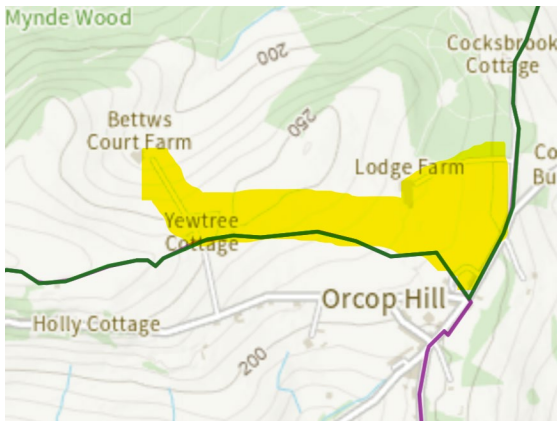
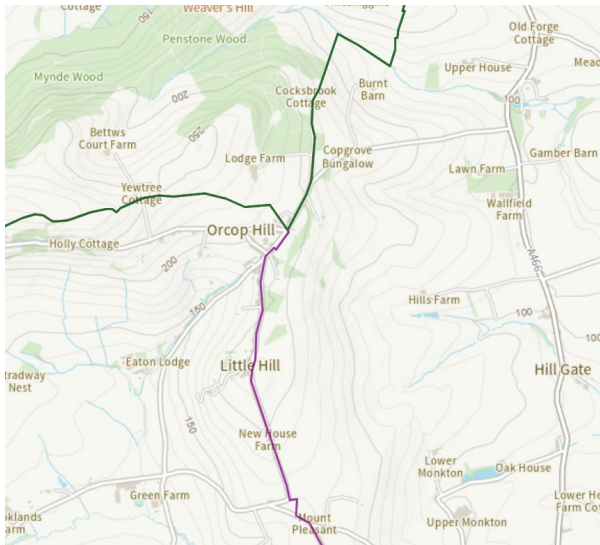
The boundary between Wormside and Birch is puzzling, particularly in Much Birch where it would seem the A49 would be a natural boundary between the two wards but Wormside extends into Much Birch and includes several properties in Kingsthorpe, on the Much Birch side of the A49 - these sit naturally in Birch Ward yet bizarrely are part of Wormside despite little physical or social connection. Similarly at Orcop, part of Orcop Hill sit in Wormside Ward despite being accessible via Birch Ward.
