Excluding the Derwent Forest/ North Ridge estate from the Great Broughton ward is inappropriate and undermines the coherence of the community. Derwent Forest is geographically and functionally linked to the settlements and landscape surrounding Great Broughton. Its exclusion would create an unnecessary that does not reflect local identity, shared interests, or established community connections. The postal addresses are numbers 1 to 24 North Ridge, GREAT BROUGHTON, Cockermouth [REDACTED] - we live in Great Broughton so to draw the boundary and place us in the Dearham ward is ridiculous. Our children go to Broughton school and proudly attend the village carnival and events in the village. My wife delivers the Great Broughton village newsletter to the village residents as we are part of that village. The roads only have footpaths that lead into Great Broughton - there is no footpath going to Broughton Moor/Dearham which is further away.
