## NEW ELECTORAL ARRANGEMENTS

### Currently there are:

- 70 councillors
- 34 wards
- Three single-councillor, twenty six two-councillor and five three-councillor wards.

### We are proposing:

- 76 councillors
- 36 wards
- Three single-councillor, twenty six two-councillor and seven three-councillor wards.

A public consultation is open until **7 September 2026**



We aim to make sure Bristol councillors represent a similar number of electors



### Currently there are:

- Seven wards that are more than 10% away from the average number of electors per ward
- No wards that are more than 30% away from the average

### Our proposals mean that:

- No wards will be more than 10% away from the average number of electors per ward
- Each councillor will represent an average of 4,799 electors
