Related subject: Sea Mills

Sea Mills is currently split between 2 wards, with part of Sea Mills in Avonmouth Ward and part of Sea Mills in Stoke Bishop Ward. This makes no sense. The whole of Sea Mills should be in one ward, not split between 2.

Sea Mills is a tightly knit community physically separated from Stoke Bishop by the Trym Valley and even more physically separated from Shirehampton by the Golf Course and the Kingsweston Estate. People living in Sea Mills have more in common with each other than with people in other places. We should be treated as one community all together in one ward, not split between 2.

Sea Mills is also both a historic Garden Suburb and a Conservation Area. It makes no sense to divide either of these into 2 parts to be treated differently by different ward councillors.

Please change the ward boundary line so that ALL of Sea Mills is in one ward, not split between 2.

Topgraphically, we are closer to Stoke Bishop. We also share the BS9 post code. It therefore makes some sense to put the whole of Sea Mills in the Stock Bishop Ward. However, if this is not possible, then I would be happy as long as Sea Mills is in one ward and not split between 2.
