## Comment text:

Dear LGBCE

I see that you are consulting on changing the ward boundaries in Bristol. I would like to offer my views.

I live in the 'bishopston & Ashley down' ward. There is a local identity of bishopston around where I live. It is centred on the Gloucester Road, which is our local high street. Currently, 2 streets down from mine you cross into 'Redland' ward. At this point the Gloucester Road becomes the boundary between wards. I think you should redraw the wards so that the central artery of our community runs through the middle of the ward.

For example, a reasonable delineation of the area that identifies as Bishopston would have the following roads as its borders (running in a clockwise direction starting at the junction of Gloucester Road and Ashley Down road):

Ashley Down Road

Chesterfield Road

Cromwell Road

Elton Road

Claremont Road

King's Drive

Kellaway Avenue (where we join the current boundary between B&AD and Henleaze)

Then turning south again through Horfield Common and down Ash Road to rejoin Gloucester Road at the junction with Ashley Down Road.

It would make sense to place the boundary between the back gardens such that people living on the same road opposite one another are in the same ward.
